

The Adriatic600 regatta is a **Category 3** race according to the **ISAF Offshore Special Regulations** (Category 3).

List of mandatory equipment that must be on board the boat before official registration:

- **Storm mainsail – if the boat does not have a sufficient number of reefs (min. 2) or does not have a furling mainsail, and a storm jib if the boat does not have a furling jib**
- **Stationary VHF radio**
- **Portable VHF radio (e.g., Motorola) or spare cable for rear VHF antenna, ready for immediate use (will be checked)**
- **Manual bilge pump**
- **Pyrotechnic signals in accordance with SOLAS Code, Chapter II – visual signals, with a valid expiration date; if no expiration date is specified, the maximum age is 4 years**
- **Life jackets for all crew members**
- **Lifelines – tensioned to the deck – and safety harnesses for all crew members**
- **Spare rudder or auxiliary steering device**
- **Rigging cutter (tool for quickly cutting ropes and wires)**
- **Life buoy with self-igniting light and floating rope**
- **Two sturdy buckets**
- **Spare navigation lights (including batteries)**
- **Two waterproof flashlights with spare batteries**
- **Fog horn**
- **Compass**
- **Anchors (main and spare) with a suitable combination of chain and rope, all ready for immediate use**
- **Plugs for kingstons (intake valves)**
- **First aid kit**
- **Navigation charts**
- **Radar reflector**
- **Inboard engine**
- **Fuel for the engine (minimum for 100 nautical miles)**
- **Drinking water for all crew members for 2 days**
- **Navigation lights**
- **Sufficient number of fire extinguishers**

Note:

If the **RO (Race Officer)** finds any irregularities during the boat inspection that may affect the safety of the race, they reserve the **right to exclude the boat from the race.**
